

# MICES Housing Project



The Divine Mercy of Almighty God has granted the 'right to live' to each and every creation! Having born in this world, nothing blocks the human rights to live in this world! When the right to live one's life to its natural end is blocked or oppressed, struggle starts ending up in a chaotic state of affairs.

'Equality in human rights' is a pertinent demand of the oppressed for centuries. Basically these human rights include 'the right to live peacefully and comfortably; the right to education; and the right to work and earn one's own living'. **Equality doesn't mean justice. Neither it means charity!** Religion, language, geographic location, race, ethnic groups, national boundaries, wealth, or political status should not come in the way of ensuring and establishing these rights!

Most charity organizations in the world are involved in charity works with the earnest belief that they are fighting for justice! When somebody spends \$1 million to have lunch with Warren Buffet, (the billionaire businessman) he is getting involved in a charity work not for a fight for justice! Indeed, the money he spends for lunch with Warren Buffet goes to Somalia, or Eritrea, or starving countries of the world! Malabar Islamic Cultural and Educational Society (MICES) was established in 1993 for this purposes with the noble motives of protection of human rights, equal rights and charity for the unfortunate sect of the society. MICES has been working since then extending an arm of assurance, hope and help to the less unfortunate people of the society and bring them up to the mainstream of social life!

Relief works are stopgap arrangement and are instantaneous by nature. It has short life! But MICES believes in long-term planning to protect the rights of the poor through its multiple activities.

MICES Housing Project was launched with such intentions.

The construction of houses for the poor started by the end of 2012. By December 2013 it is expected that all the 15 houses will be completed. The criteria for selection of inhabitants are already decided. Utmost care is taken to see that the houses are passed on to those who really deserve irrespective of caste, creed, or religion.

The moral standards of the inmates will be considered before and after allotment.

Out of these 15 houses two houses are set apart for accommodating and rehabilitating the poor, helpless people without anybody to take care. The primary objective of MICES Poor Home is to bring the unfortunate human beings left out in the wilderness of modern life, to the mainstream.
